Current Services:

The services we currently offer for vulnerable members of the community (with no other support in place) are:

- prescription collection.
- telephone conversations with volunteers (combatting loneliness).
- transport to urgent appointments (such as chemotherapy etc.).
- Limited capacity for small urgent shopping.

If you are vulnerable please contact us with other needs and we will do our best to meet them, or pass on our number to those you think may benefit.

Updates:

- In partnership with Stokesley Town Council, we are in the process of setting up a food bank in Stokesley Town Hall that will distribute to those in need (this is a separate service to the 'food parcel' service mentioned by Central Government).

We are still trying to adapt and so our services will evolve as we get more in place. All updates will be given on the newsletter.
